

#### Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

"The angel said to them, 'Do not be afraid; for behold, I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people. For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Christ and Lord."



The Season of Christmas has certainly become a time for Americans to become obsessed with "getting Christmas right." What I mean is that we have very high expectations of others and ourselves in this holy season. We think that Christmas should be a picture-perfect time, where everyone gets along, we all give and receive the perfect gifts, our homes look like something from a decorator's showroom, and our hearts are filled with great joy. When we set these high expectations and we do not feel happy, or we have to return gifts or we burn the cookies or the tree keeps falling over, we are setting ourselves up for disappointment and despair. Why should Christmas Day be more perfect than any other day in our lives?

The reality is that life—even Christmas Day—can get pretty messy. People get hurt, relationships get bruised and broken, and people feel alienated from family, friends, and even their Church. 

**Question:** Why do we give gifts at Christmas?


#### Answer




