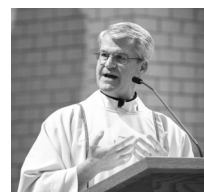

Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

"The Lord said to Abram: 'Go forth from the land of your kinsfolk and from your father's house to a land that I will show you...' Abram did as the Lord directed him."



The story of Abraham's call is the beginning of humanity's story of salvation. All three primary religions of the world (Judaism, Christianity, and Islam) recognize Abraham as the "father of all believers." God calls Abraham, an old man, to let go of his home and homeland and to go on a journey of a lifetime. If Abraham says "yes" to the call, God promises many blessings to him and his descendants. Abraham doesn't even have to think about it—he begins the journey. This is pure faith. To be able to listen to God's voice and obey, no matter what the cost may be, is an act of faith and love.

Abraham's journey took place almost three thousand years ago, and we recognize that we are also on a pilgrimage of faith. God calls us to make the sacred journey home to heaven, and as He calls us on the pilgrimage, He promises many, many blessings if we are faithful. The problem is that we get so caught up in disagreements and arguments; we seek the comforts of this world instead of seeking first the kingdom of God; we can become greedy, selfish, and prideful, and we take our eyes off the destination of heaven. Perhaps Lent is a time for us to let go of all of the daily distractions that prevent us from "walking the walk" of faith. God promises that there are so many new discoveries, accomplishments, and rewards that are waiting for us as we step forth in faith. Let us respond in faith, as did Abraham, and continue to live the calling that God has sent to each of us—to make the sacred pilgrimage home to heaven, our eternal home.

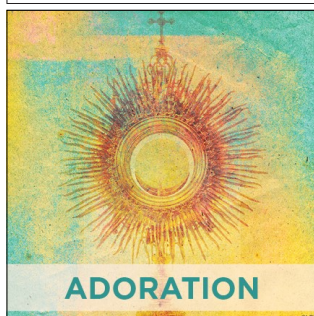

WHY DO WE DO THAT?
Catholic Life Explained:

Question:
Lent always seems to help me renew my relationship with God and strengthen my religious practice. Do you have any suggestions as to what I could do to achieve that the rest of the year?

Answer:
The obvious answer may seem to be to do whatever you do during Lent all year round. But part of the power of Lent is that we focus as a community on renewing our faith and preparing for Easter. Our Lenten practices have a purpose and a goal. Therein lies the secret. When we focus our efforts on one virtue, or try to change one bad habit, or seek to deepen our understanding of one aspect of faith, we focus our efforts and give our full attention to what we are trying to accomplish. We tend to be more successful achieving our goals. More importantly, it has a ripple effect in our lives: one thing changes or is added to the spiritual mix of our lives and many aspects are changed.

All too often we leave our spiritual growth to chance and the practice of faith to habit, and then wonder why we have no sense of growth or progress. Think of it in terms of exercise. We walk, lift weights, bend and stretch to attain the maximum benefit from what we do. In addition, to keep those benefits, we eat healthful food and get enough vitamins and rest. Spirituality requires the same kind of attention: we pray, fast, read the Bible, receive sacraments, and do charitable work to maximize the benefits of practicing faith. Keeping Lent year round keeps us in spiritual shape!
