

"Do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows." - Mt 10:31

Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

"Jesus said to the Twelve: 'Fear no one. Nothing is concealed that will not be revealed, nor secret that will not be known. What I say to you in the darkness, speak in the light; what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops."

The first piece of advice that Jesus gives as He sends the Apostles out on their first mission is not to let anyone intimidate them. Who wouldn't be intimidated!



After all, this is new to them, leaving their comfortable surroundings, leaving Jesus and their other friends, and going out into sometimes-hostile territory to spread the word about Jesus.

Surely Jesus anticipated their fear since he mentions the word "fear" three times in this passage. But the Apostles hear Jesus tell them that neither fear nor hatred can defeat His purposes. Jesus will be so close to them that He can count every hair on their head. If the Apostles keep their eye on their mission, they will have nothing to fear. And their reward will be heaven.

We all live with different fears—fears about our lives, our livelihood, our future, sickness, death, violence, and shame. These fears are all there in the lives of the Apostles too. But they went forth, fearlessly and faithfully, to proclaim the Good News that Jesus handed on to them.

This is our call too, to work through our fears and to be bold in living and proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It may be intimidating and frightening to fully embrace and live our Christian faith, but this is what Jesus expects us to do. If we are going to be called "Christian," we must live our identity.

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained:


Question: What is Lectio Divina, and how is it associated with the Benedictine Monastic tradition, whose founder, St. Benedict, we honor on July 11?

Answer: Benedict desired his monks to live in community, praying the Liturgy of the Hours together, contemplating sacred texts, and doing manual labor. The monks developed a technique to facilitate a spiritual and devotional reading of the Bible known as Lectio Divina, the holy reading of a text. This method encourages the reader to hear the biblical text with an open heart and focus on whatever God wants to highlight and then apply it to daily life.

There are variations on Lectio Divina, but essentially, the technique consists of a three-step process of reflection. When the reflection is done with a group, the responses are shared by all the participants. Once the text is selected, it is read meditatively, and the following are then explored: a word or phrase that attracts you; how and where the content of this reading touches your life today; what you believe that God wants you to do during this coming week (month, year, lifetime).

Thanks to Benedict, the Christian community has been gifted with this special way of entering into the biblical text. This week, use the Lectio Divina process on one of the readings for the coming Sunday and make a note of the life connections you are making. How is this reflection on the biblical text drawing you closer to God and others?


