

#### Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

"Some seed fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked it. But some seed fell on rich soil, and produced fruit, a hundred or sixty or thirty fold. Whoever has ears ought to hear.'

The parable that Jesus tells today registers a serious complaint, not only about the people of His time, but also about us today. God's word is sown abundantly in this world, but it usually falls on dead soil. It is



trampled, it is drying up, and it does not grow. Even though God lavishly spreads His grace over us, He does not force us to accept the gift. As strange as it sounds, the only thing that can stop the activity of God is the decisions of humanity. We have the free will to accept or reject the beauty, the forgiveness, and the life that God has to offer to us.

How often in the course of a day do we fail to recognize God speaking His love to us? How often do we refuse to allow God's word to take root and grow in our lives? The truth is that God offers us everything that we need, but we have the power to refuse it all. Let us pray that we might be even more attentive to the presence of God and His desire to share His life with us. Instead of refusing His love, let us be more aware of how we can receive His love and His grace throughout our days.

#### WHY DO WE DO THAT? **Catholic Life Explained:**

**Question:** Why do we use incense at Mass?

**Answer:** The use of incense in religious ceremonies and worship is a practice that predates Christianity, and which is also found in many other religious traditions today.

Incense, which is made from resin infused with aromatic spices and oils, is one of those fundamentally human symbols that incorporates more than one of our senses, helping us to reflect on realities that transcend the everyday details of our lives. The use of incense in the Church's liturgy — in the Mass, as well as in devotions to the Eucharist and the Liturgy of the Hours — is inspired by the use of incense in the Jewish tradition. In the writings of the Old Testament, we hear about incense being used in the worship of the temple, and Psalm 141 asks, "Let my prayer be incense before you; my uplifted hands an evening offering" (vs. 2). The image here is that, as the incense gently rises to heaven, our prayers also rise to God as something sweet and pleasant.

Another ancient use of incense that has also become part of our Catholic tradition is the idea that when we incense something, it's because it is something special or sacred. This is why the Book of the Gospel is incensed during the Liturgy of the Word and the bread, wine, priest celebrant, and congregation are incensed at the presentation of the gifts. To this, we can also add the incensing of the Blessed Sacrament during eucharistic adoration and benediction, and the body of the deceased at the end of the Mass of the Resurrection (the Funeral Mass). ©LPi
