

## Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

"I give praise to you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, for although you have hidden these things from the wise and the learned you have revealed them to little ones."

Today we hear Jesus offering a prayer of praise to His Father in heaven. Jesus is proclaiming the paradox that the "wise and the learned" know nothing about the riches that God has to offer to us. Rather, it is the poor, the outcast, and the helpless who have seen the glory of God

revealed through the love of Jesus Christ.



Being people of the kingdom has nothing to do with how much we know or how many books we read on Church teaching, morality, or spirituality. People of the kingdom of heaven are those who know God's love and mercy because they need God's presence and generosity. Those in the world who know what it means to be without shelter, food, clothing, freedom, and dignity are also those who are able to see God revealed in their lives. Sadly, the ones who set themselves up as experts and those who are powerful, wealthy, and famous will probably miss God's revelation of love because they rely too much upon themselves.

If we want to know God and experience His abundant life, we won't find it hiding in a book or in money or popularity. We find God when we listen to the voice of Jesus Christ and follow Him wherever He leads. For Jesus promises that if we take His "yoke" upon ourselves and learn from Him, we will indeed find rest. And for that reason, we give praise to our heavenly Father.


