Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

Peter got out of the boat and began to walk on the water toward Jesus. But when he saw how strong the wind was he became frightened; and, beginning to sink, he cried out, "Lord, save me!" Immediately Jesus stretched out his hand and caught Peter, and said to him, "O you of little faith, why did you doubt?"



The story of Jesus calming the sea is a beautiful parable about the life of the Church: the danger and evil of the world in the raging sea; the boat as the ark of God's people, the Church; Jesus giving his usual admonition for the Christian in every situation: "Do not be afraid." Saint Matthew has Peter step forward and ask to come out on the water with Jesus, but his faith fails him. As soon as he takes his eyes off Jesus and looks at the stormy seas, he begins to sink into the chaos.

This parable teaches us that all members of the Church must step out of the safety of the boat, take a few risks, and listen to the voice of Jesus, who will save us and guide us to do His work in the chaos of the world. We must not be bound by fear, even though the danger is real. Instead, we should recognize that Jesus is in the midst of the uncertainty and the turbulence of the world and He is near enough to rescue us if our courage and faith fail us.

"Do not be afraid." We cannot do the rest of what Jesus asks of us until we stop trembling in fear. If we want a change in the world, if we want our families, our parish, and our community to know peace and joy, we must step out of the confines of our routine lives, take a risk, and follow the gentle voice of the Good Shepherd. Jesus calls to us and invites us to lend a hand to those who are sinking into the chaos and danger of the world.





Altar Server Training Aug. 26


Question: If we have a separation of church and state, how should faith influence the way we act in society, especially for those who have a role in the government?

Answer: No matter who we are, our inner lives affect the way we interact with the world. In the United States, we have freedom of religion. That means there is no official state-sanctioned religion. This does not mean that our faith is a private affair with no impact on public life! We have the ability to freely exercise our religious beliefs in accord with our conscience. Not only do we have the option to do so, but we also have the responsibility. We're called to imitate Christ in every area of our life, not compartmentalize our faith. This means acting with respect and honoring the common humanity all we encounter. It means recognizing the person behind the politics. It also means standing up for the truth of human life and dignity, and advocating for just policies that serve the common good. The Vatican has produced a "Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church." It contains more detailed exposition of how our Catholic faith relates to various aspects of public life. **©LPi**
