THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

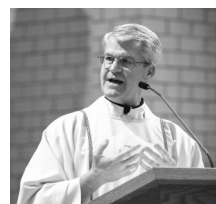
Jesus took Peter, James,

Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

Then Peter said to Jesus in reply, "Lord, it is good
that we are here. If you wish, I will make three
tents here, one for you, one for Moses, and one for
Elijah." While he was still speaking, behold, a bright
cloud cast a shadow over them, then from the
cloud came a voice that said, "This is my beloved
Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him."



Today, we celebrate the great Feast of *The Transfiguration of the Lord*. In our
Gospel from Saint Matthew, we hear that Jesus takes His closest friends
(Peter, James, and John) up the mountain, which is where faithful people
went to be close to God. In this time on the mountain, it is Jesus Himself
that reveals the closeness of God. Jesus is *transfigured* before them, and
"His face shone like the sun, and His clothes became white as light."
Because Saint Matthew is writing to a community of Jewish converts, he
connects the promises to their ancestors through Moses and Elijah, who
appear with Jesus. In this moment, God shows that Jesus is the completion
of the Old Covenant and reveals the New Covenant of salvation. As we
heard on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, God speaks from heaven to
those on the mountain and says, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am
well pleased." But during the Transfiguration, God adds, "Listen to Him."

We need that reminder, don't we? There are so many activities and people
that are vying for our attention every day, but we need to make time to
listen to Jesus. Just as Jesus took His friends to a quiet place, we need to
find that quiet time to pray, listen, meditate on Scripture, adore the Lord in
the Blessed Sacrament, and anything else that helps us to go to the
mountaintop for a few minutes. Jesus, God's Beloved Son, has something to
say to you. Are you ready to listen to Him?

Question: Why do Parishes Offer Special Masses like Thanksgiving and Memorial Day, even though they're not Holy Days of Obligation? Am I obligated to attend?

Answer: Out of respect for the various civil celebrations that take place during the year, many dioceses and parishes will host special Masses. However, while it always worthwhile to come together to worship as a community, Catholics are not obligated to attend these celebrations. As the Catechism of the Catholic Church notes, the only times that we are obligated to participate in celebrations of the Eucharist are on Sundays and holy days of obligation:

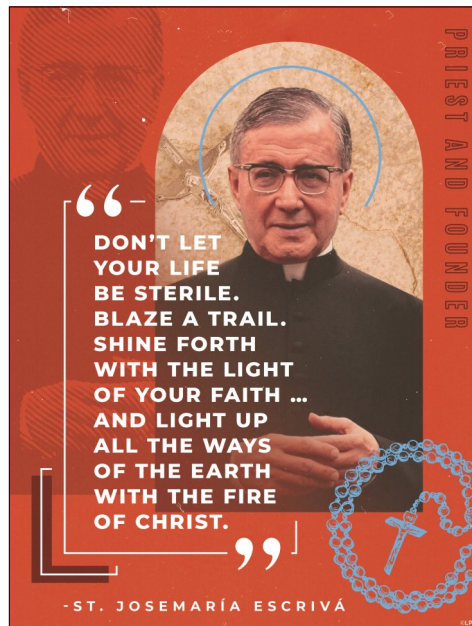
The first precept ("You shall attend Mass on Sundays and holy days of obligation and rest from servile labor") requires the faithful to sanctify the day commemorating the Resurrection of the Lord as well as the principal liturgical feasts honoring the mysteries of the Lord, the Blessed Virgin Mary, and the saints; in the first place, by participating in the Eucharistic celebration, in which the Christian community is gathered, and by resting from those works and activities which could impede such a sanctification of these days. ©LPI

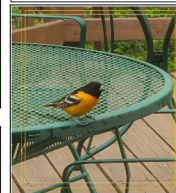

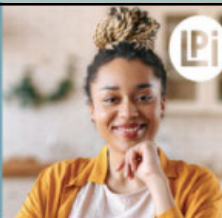

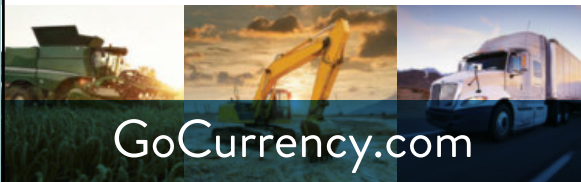
