Pastor's Message—From Father Dave

"Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? Seven times?"

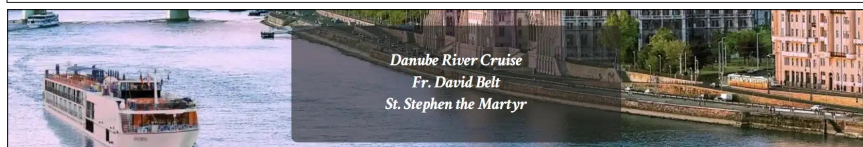
Saint Peter thought he was being generous in the number that he offered as appropriate for forgiving another person. After all, Jewish Law only required that a person be forgiven only **three** times. After that, they were treated as if they were dead. Jesus' response to Peter is a surprise, when he says, "Not seven times but seventy-seven times." Jesus answers with such a large number of "forgivenesses" that the hearer is called to understand it to mean "limitless forgiveness."

When we think of forgiveness and the challenge to forgive over and over again, we must recall how many times a day God forgives US. It would be interesting to keep a list for one day of all of our shortcomings: the angry word, the judgmental look, the uncharitable comment, the missed opportunity to help someone, the kindness that we didn't share. Within the confines of one day, the number of sins that God has forgiven in our own lives would be humbling and should cause us to reconsider how well we forgive one another.

If we adopt a constant attitude of forgiveness, exercising compassion and patience in every moment of the day, it will have an effect on every other aspect of our lives. The burden of anger, grudges, and lack of forgiveness can weigh heavily on us. Isn't it time to lay down the burden and forgive, forget, and follow Him?

"I can forgive but I cannot forget' is only another way of saying 'I cannot forgive.'" -Henry Ward Beecher

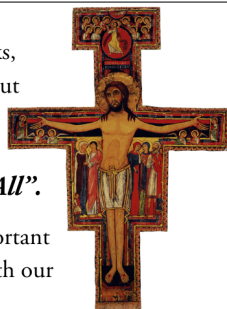
