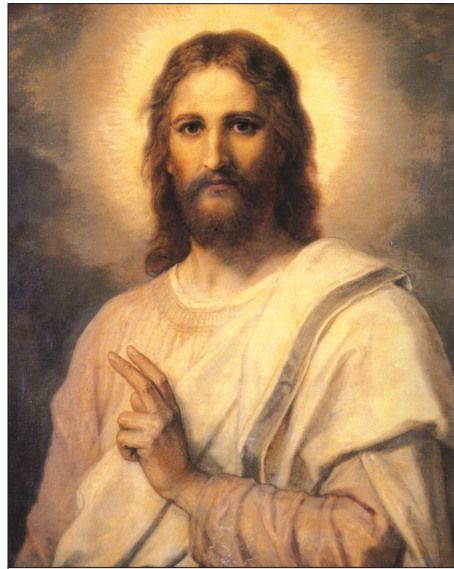

## Pastor’s Message — From Father Dave

**“Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.” He said to them, “When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come...”**



“Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples.” This request, made by one of Jesus’ disciples, shows us that the desire to pray, the desire to be in union with God is an ageless longing. The Gospel of Luke portrays Jesus at prayer many times in his ministry, especially before critical or difficult events. Prayer gives Him strength and provides the direction He needs as he continues His ministry. Jesus has taught His disciples so much about life and about God the Father. Now the disciples want to know how to pray.

The prayer that Jesus teaches presents a radical way of relating to God. Jewish faith taught that God was distant from humanity and that He should be revered and feared. Jesus teaches His followers to call God, “Father,” which gives us the image of a God that is very near to His people. Just as a faithful, loving, patient father cares for the needs of his children, God will care for us and for our needs if we call upon Him in faith.

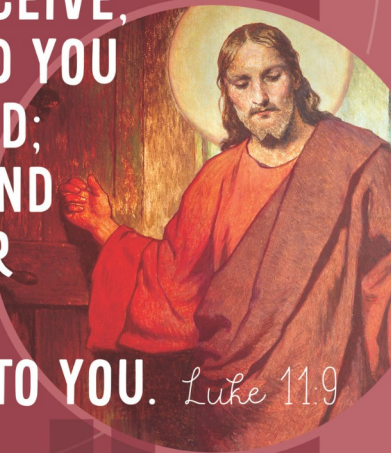
Because the Lord’s Prayer is so familiar to us, we may pray it without really paying attention to what we are saying. We are coming before the God who loves us, asking for what we need every day for life and to be forgiven in the same way that we forgive others. These are pretty bold statements, aren’t they? We are saying that we have the faith that God will provide and that we are so confident that we do a good job of forgiving others that we want God to forgive us in the same way. Do we really have the faith that God will take care of us? Do we really want God to forgive us like we forgive?

“Lord, teach us how to pray.” Jesus shows us the way to bring ourselves and our needs before the God who loves us. May we approach our Father in faith, knowing that he will hear us and provide for us.

## WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

**Question:** This time of year, I attend a lot of weddings. Why do Catholic weddings need to take place in a church?

**Answer:** Technically, there is a clause in Church law that could allow for weddings to take place outside of a church, in a suitable space under special circumstances, but it requires the rare permission of the bishop. But the meaning of marriage goes very, very deep, and the Church has a vested interest in protecting that meaning. As Catholics, we don't see a wedding as an event that needs a pleasing backdrop.

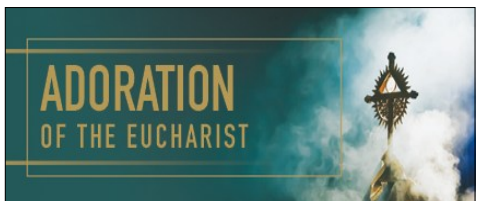
Marriage is a sacrament, both an occasion of joyful promise and symbolic solemnity. It is a spiritual event. The loving bond of marriage symbolizes the mystical union between Christ and his Church. The man and woman profess lifelong vows of fidelity, and they receive supernatural grace from God to keep their promises. Receiving the sacrament of Marriage in a church has broader symbolic meaning for the couple as well. Marriage isn't simply two people in isolation from the world around them. Marriage is the joining of families and the beginning of a new, holy mission in the life of the couple. Weddings are sacred occasions, and it's fitting that they occur in sacred spaces. ©LPi

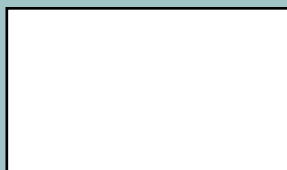
