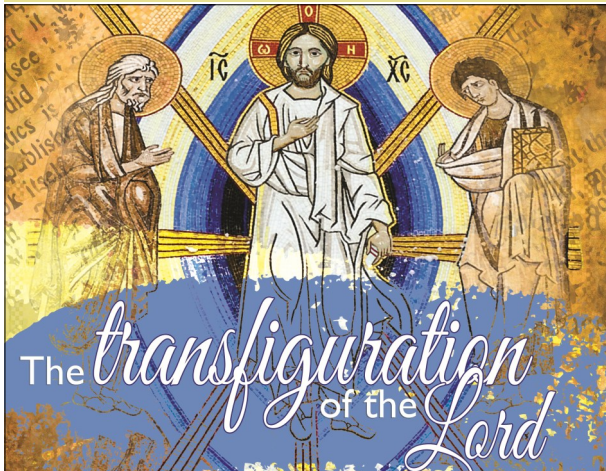

Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

Then Jesus said to the crowd, "Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions."



In my 35 years as a priest, I have never seen a moving van in a funeral procession. We all know the wise saying, "You can't take it with you." No matter how much we have accumulated in our lifetime, we have to leave it all behind when we die. This is the message that Jesus shares with us this weekend.

There is a person in the crowd who calls out to Jesus and asks Him to "tell my brother to share the inheritance with me." Jesus responds by telling a story about greed. As it does in many instances today, the death of a loved one and the division of that person's property led to an argument and a break in the deceased person's family. The man in the parable that Jesus shares is already blessed with great abundance. He plans to relax and enjoy what he has accumulated in his life, but before he can enjoy his wealth, he is told he will die. Clearly his money and his possessions will offer him no comfort in death.

The problem in the story doesn't revolve around the possessions we have accumulated but around the desire to hoard the possessions, making wealth one's highest priority. Jesus reminds His listeners that it is wise to "store up" the riches that come from knowing and trusting God, not the riches that are offered by the world. For in the end, the only thing that we will bring with us before God is an account of our lives on earth and how we used our lives, our talents, our gifts, and our resources to serve God and His people.

We can't take it with us, so maybe it is wise to use our money and our possessions to make the world a better place. What are you willing to sacrifice and to share, so that God's work of communicating His message of love, peace, and reconciliation to the world may be accomplished through us?

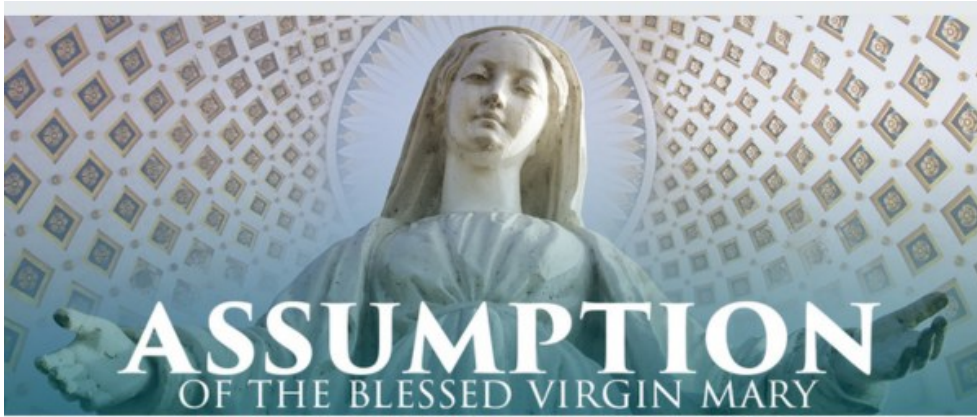

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained:

Question: When Jesus says, "You cannot serve both God and mammon," what does he mean? What is mammon?

Answer: When you hear Scripture proclaimed each Sunday, remember it wasn't originally written in English. Hebrew, Aramaic, Greek — these ancient tongues were the original language of our Old and New Testaments. Most of the time, all of the words are translated into our native language. Sometimes, a word or two is left in the original language. Such is the case in this Scripture passage.

Mammon is an ancient Aramaic word referring to money, wealth, or profit. Earthly wealth isn't bad in itself, nor does it automatically exclude us from being a disciple of Jesus. But what dominates our life? To serve money — that is, to seek accumulation of wealth for its own sake and to structure our lives around it — is morally problematic. What good is our wealth if it isn't at the service of others? What good is our wealth if its pursuit leads us to selfishness, obsession, greed, envy, and comparison? There are many things that can be opposed to our service of God — power, prestige, popularity. Ultimately, something in our lives will be our master. But there is only one God worth serving. ©LPi

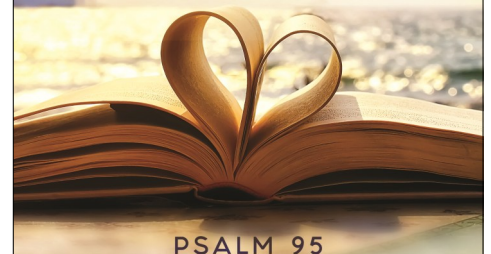

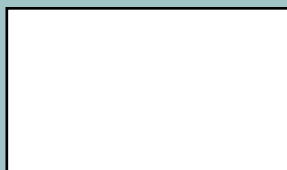
