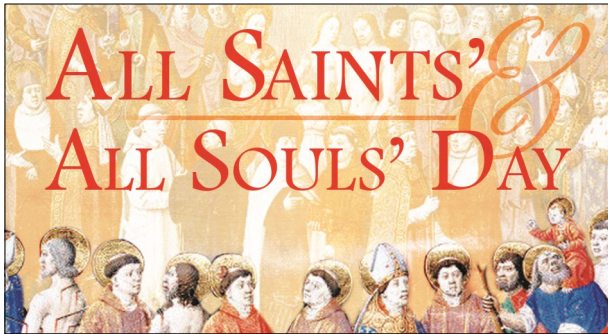

Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

"The tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed, 'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.' I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former; for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."



Jesus delivered today's parable to "some people who prided themselves on being virtuous and despised everyone else." Although the parable is very brief, its message strikes home. The portrait that is painted of the Pharisee is that he does no wrong. He is holy and faithful to the teachings of the Jewish faith. His only mistake is that he judges the tax collector: "Thank you, God that I am not greedy, dishonest, adulterous—or even like this tax collector."

The tax collector's position for prayer, bowed and beating his breast, is unusual. He has no great virtues and no religious success story to thank God for. He can only ask for God's mercy as he recognizes his sins. Jesus comments that this is the one who "went home justified." This is so because the tax collector is honest with himself and God, while the Pharisee has not really looked into his own heart.

The truth of the parable is that we are all sinners. There is no one who does not need to kneel humbly before God and ask for His love and mercy. There is no one like the Pharisee. Who could truthfully claim all of the successes that the Pharisee confesses to? There are only people who think they are good, and they are the unfortunate ones in the eyes of God. It's sad to think that the Pharisee is needy because he thinks that he has it all. In such a self-righteous attitude toward life, there is no need for a God who fills our emptiness. It is only when we recognize our shallowness and superficiality that we can be filled with the graces and goodness of God.

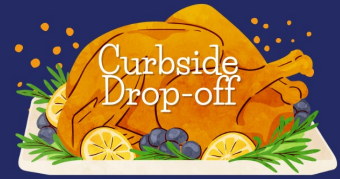

WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

Question: Why do we kneel at Mass?

Answer: Since the beginnings of the Church, kneeling has been a key posture of prayer. We see Sts. Peter and Paul in the Acts of the Apostles kneeling in prayer. Early in the 4th century, the Council of Nicea prohibited kneeling on Sundays and special feasts. Kneeling began more as a posture of penance for our sins, but in the history of the Church, it has become more a posture of reverence and solemn prayer.

You will notice that the times we kneel at Mass are tied to the consecration of the holy Eucharist. We kneel in both anticipation of what will occur and then in awe of what has taken place: Jesus Christ becomes truly present to us under the guise of bread and wine. The profoundness of this event has over time led the Church to mandate in the current General Instruction of the Roman Missal that kneeling is the only posture allowed during this time. The sheer awesomeness of the holy Eucharist leads us to fall to our knees in wonder and thanksgiving. ©LPi

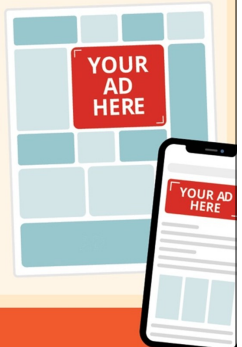
