Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

**"The Lord said to me: 'You are my servant, Israel,
through whom I show my glory... I will make you a light
to the nations, that my salvation may reach to the ends
of the earth.'"**



In our first reading this weekend, the Lord is speaking through the prophet Isaiah to the nation of Israel. The Israelites have turned their backs upon God, who loved them with all His heart. Because of their sinfulness, God allowed their enemy to come in, destroy their homeland, and take the survivors into exile in the foreign land of Babylon. After they have spent a number of years far from their homeland, God sends Isaiah to tell them that they will be freed and will be able to go back to the Promised Land and rebuild their lives. God tells them that, in their freedom and in their faithfulness, they will be the instrument through which God's love and justice will enter the entire world.

Because of God's immense love for us, we too have been called to be a light to the nations. God's message of peace, forgiveness, and salvation must come to the world through us and through the way that we live our lives. By virtue of our baptism, we have all been called children of God and have been given a mission to accomplish here on earth. There has never been a promise that this mission would be easy to accomplish. In fact, through the example of Jesus Himself we learn that faithfulness to God means that we have to endure hardship and suffering. Even the Son of God lost His life because of the message that He was proclaiming.

Are you ready to pour out your life in service to God and His people? The only way that this dark world of ours will experience the light of God's love is if God's people are faithful to their baptismal call to be a "light to the nations." Be a light. Share the blessings that God has given to you with the people around you. And be assured that God's strength will uphold you and guide you.

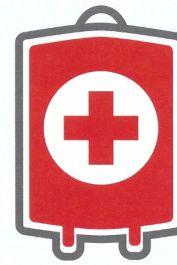

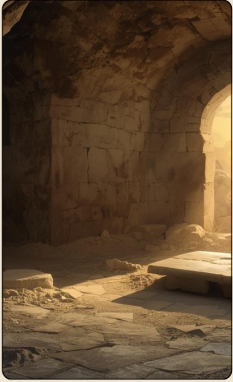

WHY DO WE DO THAT?

Catholic Life Explained:

Question: How many times a day can a person receive communion?

Answer: To find an answer to this question, we need to turn to the Church's Code of Canon Law. Here we read, "One who has received the blessed Eucharist may receive it again on the same day only within a Eucharistic celebration in which that person participates ..." (no. 917). This tells us that the standard answer would be that we can receive communion twice in a day.

Having said that, we also want to be sure that we pay attention to the entire instruction. The phrase "within a Eucharistic celebration in which that person participates" is important. It means a) that we always have to think of receiving communion as being within a celebration of the Mass and b) we have to be participants in that celebration – we can't simply show up "in time" for communion.

So, when would this rule apply?

For example, if you attend Mass on a Saturday morning and then take part in the Sunday Vigil Mass on Saturday evening, you could licitly receive communion at both celebrations. Or, another example, if you receive communion at a wedding or funeral Mass, you could also receive communion at a daily Mass or Sunday Vigil celebrated on the same day. We always want to be sure that we observe the rules for fasting from food and drink before receiving the eucharist (see Code of Canon Law, no. 919).

We should also remember that the Code of Canon Law instructs that anyone who is in danger of death or seriously ill may also receive communion a second time (no. 91, §2). ©LPI
