Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

"Jesus came down with the twelve and stood on a stretch of level ground with a great crowd of his disciples and a large number of the people from all Judea and Jerusalem and the coastal region of Tyre and Sidon. And raising his eyes toward his disciples he said: "Blessed are you..."



In our Gospel this weekend, St. Luke tells the story of Jesus teaching the Beatitudes to His disciples. In these brief but powerful teachings, Jesus shows us the way to find "beatitude" or happiness in life. Jesus tells us that being poor, hungry, and an object of scorn and rejection will bring us happiness. I don't know about you, but that doesn't quite sound right, does it? How could poverty, hunger, and rejection bring happiness to our lives? One of the realities of life is that, many times, a difficult situation causes us to make changes. Most people, for example, do not seek medical attention until an illness is already taking its toll. Most alcoholics don't begin a treatment program until they have "bottomed out." Until a divorce is imminent, most people in a dysfunctional marriage won't seek counseling. Pain in our lives is a call to action. Suffering can make us take care of ourselves.

Jesus realizes this when he tells us that being poor, hungry, and rejected will bring us happiness. Instead of complaining about the sufferings and hardships that we carry in life, the Beatitudes teach us that there is always a blessing in disguise, a lesson in every hardship that we endure. Pain tells us that something must change.

As we begin a new week, let us be mindful of the ways that we endure pain and suffering. Let us offer these hardships to the Lord, knowing that He will help us carry these difficult burdens. Let us also look for the blessings that come with carrying these burdens. May we always know that the greatest blessing, promised to us by Jesus, is that if we are faithful in living through pain and suffering, our reward will be great in heaven.



WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

Question: Can you explain what we mean by a vocation or calling? I have heard this term used in many different contexts and am not sure what it means. Does it apply to religious life?

Answer: A vocation or calling refers to a spiritual experience whereby a person senses within oneself the closeness of God and what he is asking in one's life. It is a realization of what one's part in God's plan could be. Vocation comes in all kinds of ways. Some are as dramatic as St. Paul's, being knocked off his horse, blinded, and hearing God's voice. Others are less dramatic, often occurring over time through little events and personal interests. Others happen in a hurry, accompanied by great spiritual insight or conversion. We often think that this applies to religious vocation, but in fact, every Christian has a vocation, a calling to serve others in and through the church. Whether married or single, religious or lay, we are all called to live out our baptismal commitment to preach and teach the Gospel message. Each of us has our role to play in God's plan, and we become coworkers with God in the work of redemption. With a little confidence, a willing spirit and God's grace, we can and will respond to his unique call. ©LPi
