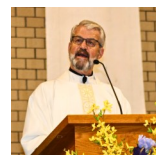

Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

"You are the light of the world. A city set on a mountain cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and then put it under a bushel basket; it is set on a lampstand, where it gives light to all in the house. Just so, your light must shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your heavenly Father."



As I was writing this article, I noticed that Jesus doesn't say, "You will be the light..." Jesus tells us that we already are the light of the world. The problem is that most of us don't believe it or we are afraid to let the light of Christ shine in our hearts. Many times we wear the bushel basket of sin over the light, and the darkness of evil tries to extinguish the presence of Christ within us. The good news is that the light can never be extinguished, no matter how seriously we have sinned or how far we have walked away from God. Because God chose us at our Baptism, that relationship, that light, will last forever.

The other point I noticed this week is Jesus teaches that, when people see our good deeds, it should lead them to glorify God. I think that sometimes we believe that our good deeds are about us and not about God. If we are doing good things to get peoples' attention, then we are doing them for the wrong reason. Our good and faithful lives must be beacons that lead people to God.

As we go through this next week, pray about the "bushel basket" of sin that needs to be removed from your lives. Ask God to give you the gift of grace, so that you may see your sinfulness and have the desire to remove the darkness from your life. It is only through Jesus Christ, the true Light of the World, that the darkness of our own lives can be confronted and conquered.

"If you remove from your midst oppression, false accusation, and malicious speech; if you bestow your bread on the hungry and satisfy the afflicted; then light shall rise for you in the darkness, and the gloom shall become for you like midday." -Isaiah 58: 9-10 (From the First Reading of today's Mass)

WHY DO WE DO THAT? Catholic Life Explained:

Question: Are near-death experiences real?

Answer: There is a lot of curiosity and fascination with the idea of an afterlife and communicating with those who have died. In movies, television shows, and numerous books, people make claims about their ability to communicate with the dead, or having had a near-death experience. There is no objective way to verify any of this. While details about people and events can be surprisingly accurate, it is just circumstantial evidence that might be explained in other ways.


On the other hand, when people have unusual experiences, sometimes called near-death or out-of-body, it is real to them. They react with the emotions and thoughts that one would expect. At times, they report details they could not have known any other way, such as bits of conversation, or meeting people they had never known in this life. So certainly, to the person, they experience something. We believe in a life after death, we believe in the communion of saints. These things are not a contradiction to faith, but we should not base our faith on them, nor change our beliefs. They are unexplained and will likely remain so. ©LPi
