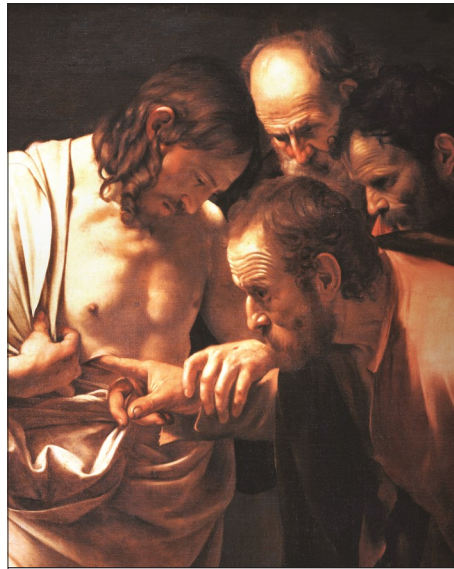

## Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

**Jesus came and stood in their midst and said to them, 'Peace be with you.' When He had said this, He showed them His hands and His side. The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you...'**



On the evening of the first day of the week, the disciples are sitting in the upper room, locked away because of fear and confusion. Mary Magdalene has brought them her news: "I have seen Him!" They did not believe what she told them, but they came together to wait for Him. Suddenly He stood in their midst. He spoke to them and gave them their mission. He said that He is sending them in the same way that the Father sent Him into the world. Even when they are not invited into peoples' lives, they must go anyway to forgive sin and bring peace to a broken world. Jesus even gave them the gift of the Spirit that day, so that they would have God's presence and power with them every step of the journey.

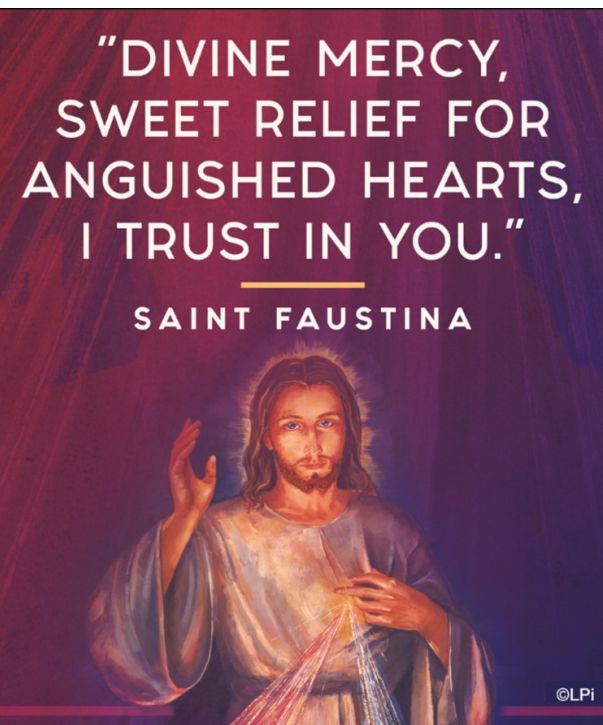
What happened next? Did they do what He told them to do? No. They did not go outside of the locked room. They did not go out to forgive sin or to heal the world. They remained together, locked away in fear. Finally Thomas comes in late. They told him that they had seen the Lord and how He had sent them into the world. It was then that Thomas started to doubt. If they had really had seen Him, if He had really sent them into the world, if He had armed them with the power of the Holy Spirit, why were they still sitting here?

So often when we hear the story about Doubting Thomas we compare ourselves to his lack of faith. But what about the lack of faith shown in the others who stayed locked away in fear after receiving the Holy Spirit? We ourselves have received an abundance of the Spirit's presence and love in Baptism and Confirmation, and our faith is strengthened every time we receive the Lord's resurrected presence in the Eucharist. If that is the case, why aren't we taking up the mission that was given to us—the same mission given by Jesus to the disciples?

In this Easter season, it is time for us to trust in the power of the Spirit that has been given to us, get out of our comfortable chairs, and do the work of healing, forgiving, and loving that has been entrusted to us. When other people see us and the way that we choose to live our lives, do they see people filled with the Holy Spirit, or do they ask, "How can we believe in the resurrection of the Lord when they are not living their faith in Him?"

**WHY DO WE DO THAT?**  
**Catholic Life Explained:**


**Question:** Where did the feast of Divine Mercy come from?

**Answer:** If you were born well before the year 2000, you know the feast of Divine Mercy has not always been celebrated in the Church. In the early 1900s, a young Polish nun began receiving private revelations. Jesus appeared to her during her times of prayer, speaking a message of mercy and love for the world. She received a set of prayers — the Divine Mercy Chaplet — and the request to have a feast day established to remind the Church of the mercy of God. St. Faustina died in 1938, on the cusp of war and in the midst of one of the most violent centuries in the history of the world.

Her story and her diaries began circulating in Poland and beyond. It quickly became apparent that this was a holy young woman, and the cause for her canonization opened. In the year 2000, she was canonized by the first-ever Polish pope, St. John Paul II. On her canonization day, he established the second Sunday of Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday, "a perennial invitation to the Christian world to face, with confidence in divine benevolence, the difficulties and trials that mankind with experience in the years to come." ©LPI

## Knights of Columbus News

### Pilgrim Icon: "Sacred Heart of Jesus" April 19th—26th

The Knights of Columbus Council #10160 will be hosting the "Sacred Heart of Jesus" Icon April 19th to April 26th in the Gathering Space.

This icon depicts the most famous image of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, painted in 1767 by Pompeo Batoni and now venerated in the Church of the Gesù in Rome. This reproduction of the original image bears the blessing of Pope Francis and is one of more than 300 icons traveling across the world as part of the Knights of Columbus Pilgrim Icon Program.

Supreme Knight Patrick Kelly has said that as Knights bring these icons across the world to their parishes, he hopes "they will invite their families, and all families, to consecrate their homes and themselves to the Sacred Heart." He further said, "In the heart of Christ, we see the heart of the Father, and we ask our Lord to help us make his heart our own, so that we may see and love in others what he sees and loves in us."


