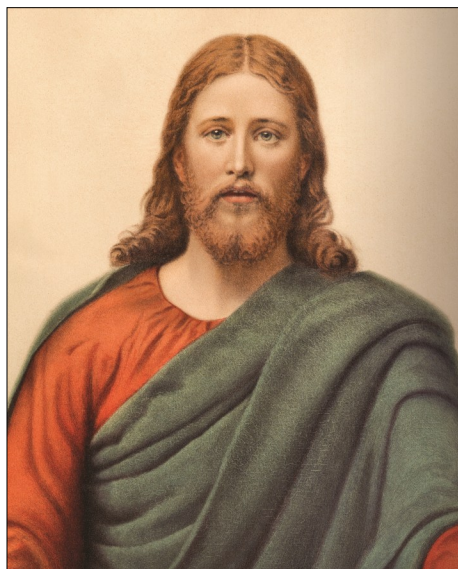

Pastor's Message — From Father Dave

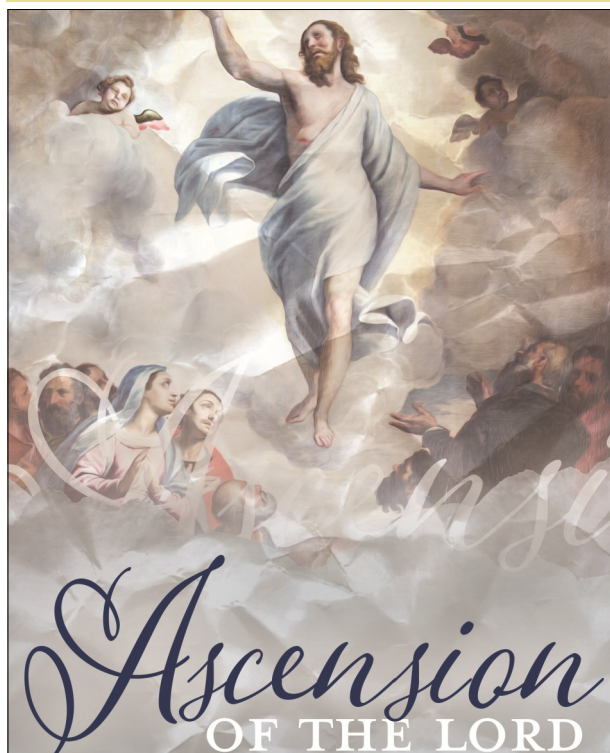
"Jesus raised His eyes to heaven and said, 'Father, the hour has come... I will no longer be in the world, but they are in the world, while I am coming to you.'"

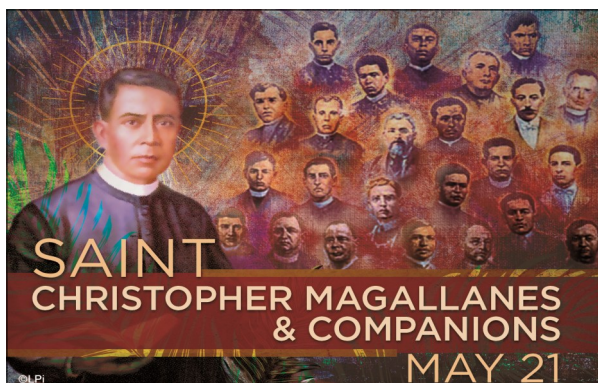

Catholic Life Explained:

Question: What lessons should I learn from the Assumption of Mary?

She shows us how to be faithful to God's will, living each day with confidence in God's mercy and love. At the Nativity, in Jesus' public ministry, and at the Crucifixion, we see her steadfast trust. In the Preface of the Mass for the Assumption of Mary, we pray: "For today the Virgin Mother of God was assumed into heaven as the beginning and image of your Church's coming to perfection and a sign of sure hope and comfort to your pilgrim people."

It is this image of holiness that we strive to imitate. In the office, at home, or in our community, we look for signs of God's grace that call us to an ever greater love of him and each other. 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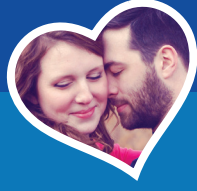
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
